Matured in carefully selected new and seasoned French and American oak barriques to give an iconic robust flagship red. This Shiraz is great drinking now and will continue to improve by cellaring up to 2015.

Aroma: A fragrant mix of black fruits with lifted pepper and a hint of eucalypt.

Palate: Ripe, firm savoury blackcurrant and black cherry flavours balanced by fine supple tannins. Good fruit weight and a liberal helping of oak treatment make for an exquisitely balanced wine.

Oak: 100% maturation in new and seasoned French and American oak barriques for 14 months
