The Top Drawer 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon

86% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Shiraz
100% Estate grown Cabernet - Geographe

A smooth elegant Cabernet with plenty of lifted berry fruit flavours, this wine exhibits persistence and exquisite balance. A light to medium bodied red that has been carefully matured in predominantly new and seasoned French oak to give softness and complexity as well as balance. Can be enjoyed from release, but will improve if left to cellar up to 2014.

Aroma: Lifted hedgerow berries and herbs

Palate: Mixture of intense briar berry fruits balanced with oak to give a fine structure. Palate is tight but with great fruit intensity. Ripe, firm tannins are well balanced with fruit weight.

Oak: 100% maturation in new and seasoned French and American oak for 14 months

Analysis: pH: 3.38 Acid: 6.6g/L Alc: 13.5%
