25% Shiraz

A stylish and elegant deep purple wine, with a seamless fruit driven blend of Cabernet and Shiraz. Ripe cherry and blackcurrant flavours mix with elegant use of oak give this wine a sensational appeal for enjoying with most dishes. Sparing use of oak results in a soft, fruit driven wine with good structure and mouth feel. Hints of liquorice and pepper mingle to give extra complexity.

Aroma: Blackcurrant and briar fruits

Palate: Ripe blackcurrant and briar fruit with a delicate hint of liquorice in the mid palate. Ripe tannins and good balance between oak and fruit weight.
