Always ones to aim high, Barton Jones Wines are focussed on quality over quantity and in only a handful of vintages they have created some head-turning wines, from the 35 year old dry grown vineyard.



2011 CABERNET SAUVIGNON / SHIRAZ

55% Cabernet Sauvignon,
45% Shiraz

100% Geographe

A stylish fruit driven example of a great 'Aussie Claret' with a deep purple colour and a seamless blend of Cabernet and Shiraz. Ripe cherry and blackcurrant flavours mingle with restrained use of oak give this wine a sensational appeal for enjoying with most meat dishes. This easy drinking fruit driven style has great structure and a smooth mouth feel with lingering hints of oak to add a little complexity.

Aroma: Blackcurrant and briar fruits

Palate: Ripe blackcurrant and briar fruit with a delicate hint of liquorice in the mid palate. Ripe tannins and good balance between oak and fruit weight.
