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## WINES

Barton Jones Wines is a small boutique affair, created by Jackie Barton and Adrian Jones. Located in Geographe an area renowned for its abundance of fresh local produce; the aim is to produce premium Geographe wines which reflect the grape varietals and show regional expression.

Always ones to aim high, Barton Jones Wines are focussed on quality over quantity and in only a handful of vintages they have created some head-turning wines, from the 35 year old dry grown vineyard.



### THE SHILLY-SHALLY 2011 CHENIN BLANC

86% barrel aged Chenin Blanc, 14% Chenin Blanc  
100% Estate grown, Geographe

After heavy crop thinning fruit was picked ripe and following fermentation in stainless steel was transferred to seasoned French oak barriques. Prior to bottling an unwooded chenin blanc component was blended to add vibrancy and freshness.

Oak adds toasty honeycomb notes and a creamy mouth feel which adds to the complexity of the fresh fruit characteristics of this varietal wine. Complexity will be gained by this elegant wine on cellaring.

**Colour:** Light straw with a greenish tinge

**Aroma:** Vibrant stone fruit and toasted cashew

**Palate:** Apricot and nectarine mingle with honeycomb and toasty oak to give layers of flavour to excite the palate. A creamy texture and mouth filling fruits make for a great food wine.

**Oak:** 86% Chenin Blanc matured in seasoned French oak barriques for 10 months

**Analysis:** pH: 3.17      **Acid:** 6.28g/L      **Alc:** 13.0%
