Barton Jones Wines is a small boutique affair, created by Jackie Barton and Adrian Jones. Located in Geographe an area renowned for its abundance of fresh local produce; the aim is to produce premium Geographe wines which reflect the grape varietals and show regional expression.

Always ones to aim high, Barton Jones Wines are focussed on quality over quantity and in only a handful of vintages they have created some head-turning wines, from the 35 year old dry grown vineyard.



THE BRILLIANT CUT 2012 SEMILLON SAUVIGNON BLANC

86% Semillon, 14% Sauvignon Blanc
100% Barrel aged Semillon, 100% Tank fermented Sauvignon Blanc
86% Semillon, Geographe, 14% Sauvignon Blanc, Pemberton

Semillon and sauvignon blanc were fermented separately. Following fermentation semillon was transferred to seasoned French oak barriques. The remaining sauvignon blanc was tank fermented and left on lees. The sauvignon blanc parcel was then blended with the wooded semillon component prior to bottling.

Oak adds depth and complexity to the fresh fruit characteristics of the unwooded parcel resulting in a creamy mix of stone fruit and citrus with lifted cut grass and hints of toasty oak. An elegant wine with balance which will gain in complexity by cellaring.

- Aroma:** Fresh cut grass, citrus, stone fruit
- Palate:** Plenty of fresh citrus with hints of stone fruit and crunchy greens, balanced with delicate warm and spicy, savoury oak and a tropical fruit note on the finish. Balance between fruit, acid and oak treatment gives an engaging wine to savour with food.
- Oak:** 100% semillon matured in seasoned French oak barriques for 8 months
