- Review:** The wine is made from Shiraz grapes, and given only a few hours skin contact after crushing. This process extracts lots of fresh berry flavours and just a touch of colour, an attractive vibrant pink. The palate is fine and lively, with soft berry character of raspberry and strawberry, brimming with flavour, balanced by soft acid. A great medium dry wine. Drink it chilled, with spicy food, salmon or light pasta dishes.
